You will have excellent research and analytical thinking, excellent written communication skills, critical thinking and project management skills.

Responsibilities: You will be required to work through the funding database and apply for funding applications by writing funding proposals and applications to donor organisations based on feedback from GMA board of trustees/membership. You will be required to apply at least 3-5 funding application for the whole internship. The successful projects will be launched in 2021.

Mentoring Opportunity: You will also get an opportunity to be mentored by one of GMA members. This will help you develop your professional and personal career ambitions in International development and/or related fields. You will also get insight into GMA's established projects.

Location and working hours: This is a home-based role. Your working hours will be flexible and can be tailored around your needs. You will be line-managed by one of the trustees of the organisation.
